

Friday Night Mixed

2019 – 2020 League Rules

1. This organization shall be known as the Friday Night Mixed. This will be a USBC (United States Bowling Congress) Sanctioned handicap league. The following regulations have been in effect or voted on since the Friday Night Mixed league started in 1978.
2. League officers for the 2019 – 2020 season are:
President: John Phelan 815-485-7247

3. The board of directors shall consist of the officers and team captains. The board shall decide on any disputes or protest and it is within its power to discipline any member or team for violation of any provision of the league rules or USBC rules and regulations.
4. The president must verify monthly bank statements and comply with the bonding protection rule of the USBC.
5. This league will bowl on Fridays at 6:30pm starting on September 6, 2019 and ending on April 17, 2020. A Friday Night Mixed league team consists of either three (3) women and one (1) man, three (3) men and one (1) woman or two (2) women and two (2) men. Max of 8 people on a team roster.
6. Sanctioning: All members' sanction fees must be paid the first week of bowling in order for scores to count. It is the team captain's responsibility to make sure all their team members are aware that Friday Night Mixed is league sanctioned through the USBC Joliet Association. Sanction fee for this year is \$25.00 for both men and women. All awards will not be in effect unless a bowler is sanctioned. Outside association fee is \$10.00 for both men and women. It is the secretary's responsibility to turn in all sanctioning thirty days after league start.
7. The weekly team match-ups and position rounds are played according to the pre-printed schedule provided by the USBC, with the revisions made for a full season. Team lineups will be determined at the first night of bowling. The full season is as follows:
Weeks 1-10, Week 11 position round
Weeks 12-21, Week 22 position round
Weeks 23-31, Week 32 position round
Week 33 – The winners of each 1/3 (or 2nd place if a team has already won a third) plus 1 wild card will roll off to determine the league champion.
Roll Off Rule: The 4 playoff teams will be ranked by total wins and compete in a stepladder final. Lanes 7-8 will be used for match play and lanes 9-10 will be used for the playoff teams not in match play.
 - First match: 4th seed vs. 3rd seed
 - Second match: Winner of first match vs. 2nd seed
 - Third match: Winner of second match vs. 1st seed

8. Handicap is 90% of 220 per bowler. USBC book average from previous season will be used for the first 3 weeks while bowlers are establishing average.
9. We have a contract with Laraway Lanes for 12 lanes. We have to pay for every bowler/lane that we use for scoring. Vacant bowlers count towards payment. Any shortages in the league account will be deducted from that team's prize money. If a team is missing a bowler, please have your team's captain let the league secretary or any league officer know if there is a problem in finding a replacement. We will do our best to help you find someone.
10. Bowling fees are \$17.00 per bowler per week for the 2019-2020 bowling season. The breakdown of the league fees are as follows:

Linage	\$ 11.25 per week
Prize Fund	\$ 5.75 per week
Secretary	\$ 200.00 (Donation to Laraway Youth Scholarship Fund)
Treasurer	\$ 400.00 per season

Team prize money is given to the team captain at the end of the season to be distributed to the team members.

11. The team captain's responsibilities are to make sure all league fees are paid each week. Don't let your team get behind in the weekly fees as any team's shortages are deducted from the team prize fund at the end of the season. The league does not absorb the loss. All bowling fees will be due by April 3rd, 2020. We are now paying for the last week of bowling. No checks will be accepted the last 2 weeks of bowling.
12. A person can be no more than two (2) weeks behind in paying for bowling. If they are, their score does not count. All money must be completely paid for by position rounds or that individual cannot bowl. After position round, if the fee is still not paid, bowling for that individual person will not be allowed until paid in full. Their scores will not count and they will receive a ZERO (0) for all games until paid. Please talk to the treasurer if there are any issues.
13. Scoring System: This is a seven (7) point system; two (2) points per game and one (1) point per series. Team standings are based on total points and games won/lost. We cannot go by total pins scratch as in the previous rules because this is a handicap league.
14. The absentee score is the bowler's average minus ten (10) pins with that bowler's handicap. Individual vacancy score will be 120 with a 90 handicap.
15. Tardiness – Tardy bowlers will be allowed to catch up, provided that they notify the opposing team captain that they are present before the end of the 5th frame of the opposing team. Those who come in later will not be allowed to PACE.

16. All new subs need to check in with an officer before bowling starts. No new subs may be added to the 8 person roster during the last six weeks of bowling. This year's cutoff date is March 13, 2020. In case of an emergency, a captains' meeting can be called to vote on amending this rule.
 - a. Floating Sub Rule:
 - i. Cannot bowl position round
 - ii. Must pay sanction fee
 - iii. Cannot pre-bowl
17. Forfeit Rule – A legal team must have two (2) members on their roster present by the end of the opposing team's first frame. Failure to fulfill this requirement will result in the team's ineligibility for points for that game. If a team does not have a legal lineup, the opposing team does have to bowl their team average minus forty (40) pins in order to win their points. Scores still count towards averages for the bowlers that do bowl.
18. Legal Line-up – Each team must have two (2) permanent bowlers at the beginning of the 1st frame of the first game to be considered a legal line-up. Pre-bowls count. All subs on a team's roster need to be sanctioned.
19. Pre-bowling – Subs may not pre-bowl. A permanent team member or team may pre-bowl for any night with the exception of the following: **NO PRE-BOWLING FOR POSITION ROUNDS OR ROLL OFFS.** As voted, if a team member or team has to pre-bowl, they just have to notify one (1) person on the opposing team that they would be bowling. It does not have to be the team captain. An individual may also notify one of the officers, who in turn must notify a member of the opposing team. If an individual is pre-bowling, it is their responsibility to notify their own team so they can get their scores from the counter. (Etiquette for pre-bowling) **YOU MUST PAY FOR YOUR BOWLING THE NIGHT YOU PRE-BOWL AT THE COUNTER.** (Your money along with your scores go into an envelope and will be given to your captain or an officer if your team is absent)
20. A sub can bowl position round, week 11, only if that sub has 12 games bowled. A sub can bowl position round, week 22, only if that sub has 18 games bowled. A sub can bowl position round, week 32, only if that sub has 21 games bowled. Also the same do apply for the last week, week 32. 21 games bowled are considered to be a legal average.
21. If at the completion of a 1/3 there is a tie for first place, a 1 game roll off will take place immediately.
22. Individual awards are paid in both scratch & handicap categories, but individual may only cash in one (1). Bowlers cannot cash in both high game and high game handicap. This is also the case for team game and series awards.
23. To qualify for individual awards, a bowler must be a permanent team member and bowl 51 games by April 10, 2020. As voted, a sub cannot win individual prizes unless they pay into the prize fund.
24. Team Franchise Fee (this is for holding your spot on the league) will be due the last night of bowling. The franchise fee is non-refundable and only good for the team you paid for at the end of the previous season. Team captains must list who is paying for the franchise fee on the team. If a team member does not pay the fee on the last night of bowling, the first person to get this fee to the league treasurer has the spot. As soon as the treasurer has the fee, they will contact the captain. So, if a team member quits the league or joins another team the previous franchise fee is forfeited to the league.

25. We understand that you may have to bring your children with you on Friday nights; however, we are asking that they not run around and are never on the tiled area.
26. Smoking – Please be courteous; if your first bowler smokes and is done bowling then by all means, go have your cigarette. The whole team should not be out at the same time.
27. In addition to the above rules, USBC rules will govern the operation of the league.

Beat the Champs: Our league will participate 100%. The cost is \$3.00 per bowler which will come out of the prize money. Beat the Champ date will be December 13, 2019 for our league. Pre-Bowls are NOT allowed.
